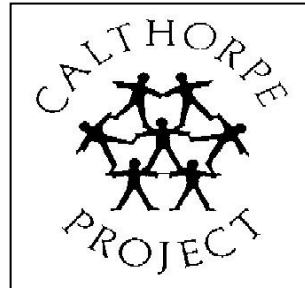

Thank you for your interest in the post of Children's Weekend Sport & Physical Activity Co-ordinator.

The deadline for returning completed applications is **Thursday February 7th** 2019 at 5pm. Interviews take place **Saturday February 16th** and applicants who have been successfully shortlisted will be contacted by Wednesday February 13th. Due to time constraints, only applicants who are to be interviewed will be contacted.

Candidates will be shortlisted solely on the information contained in their application form. It is important that you demonstrate how your experience, knowledge and skills address the requirements of the post as set out in the Job Description. To be shortlisted you will have to **demonstrate that you meet all the elements of the Essential Criteria** in the Person Specification.

We are committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children, young people and adults and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. As you are applying for a post which will bring you into direct contact with vulnerable groups, including children, you must ensure that you include on your application a full education/employment/training history from when you left school. We will require you to account for any gaps or anomalies in your application. The successful candidate will be required to obtain a new DBS form.
